## **Weathering & Erosion**

Weathering is the process of breaking down rocks. This can happen in two different ways. One way is physical weathering, such as when ice widens cracks in the roads to make potholes. The second way is chemical weathering, like when water dissolves rock.

Erosion is the process of moving the pieces of rock to a different place. Water, wind, or ice can help move these rock pieces.

New rock is carried by water
